
Welcome to the Deer Path Art League 60th Anniversary Art Fair on the Square

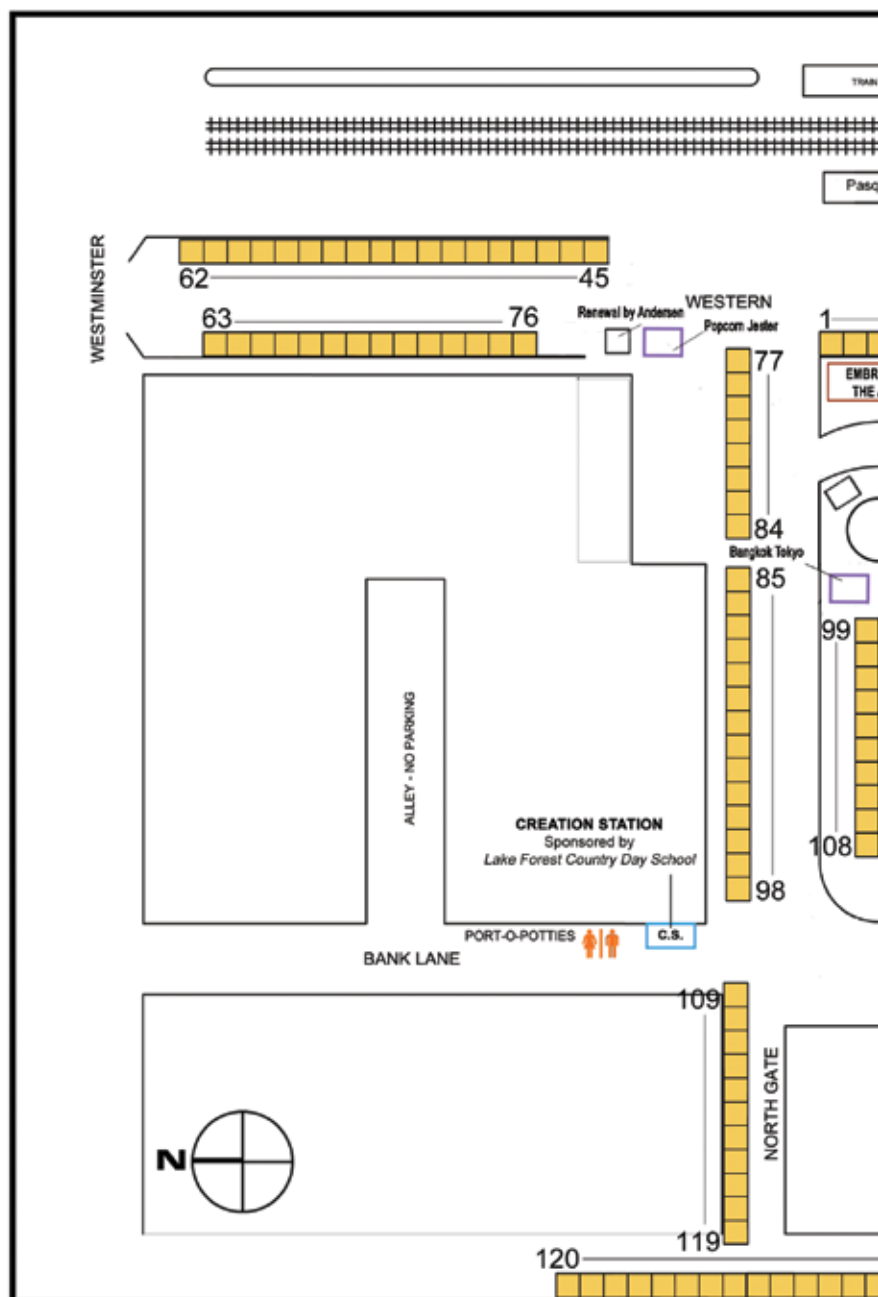

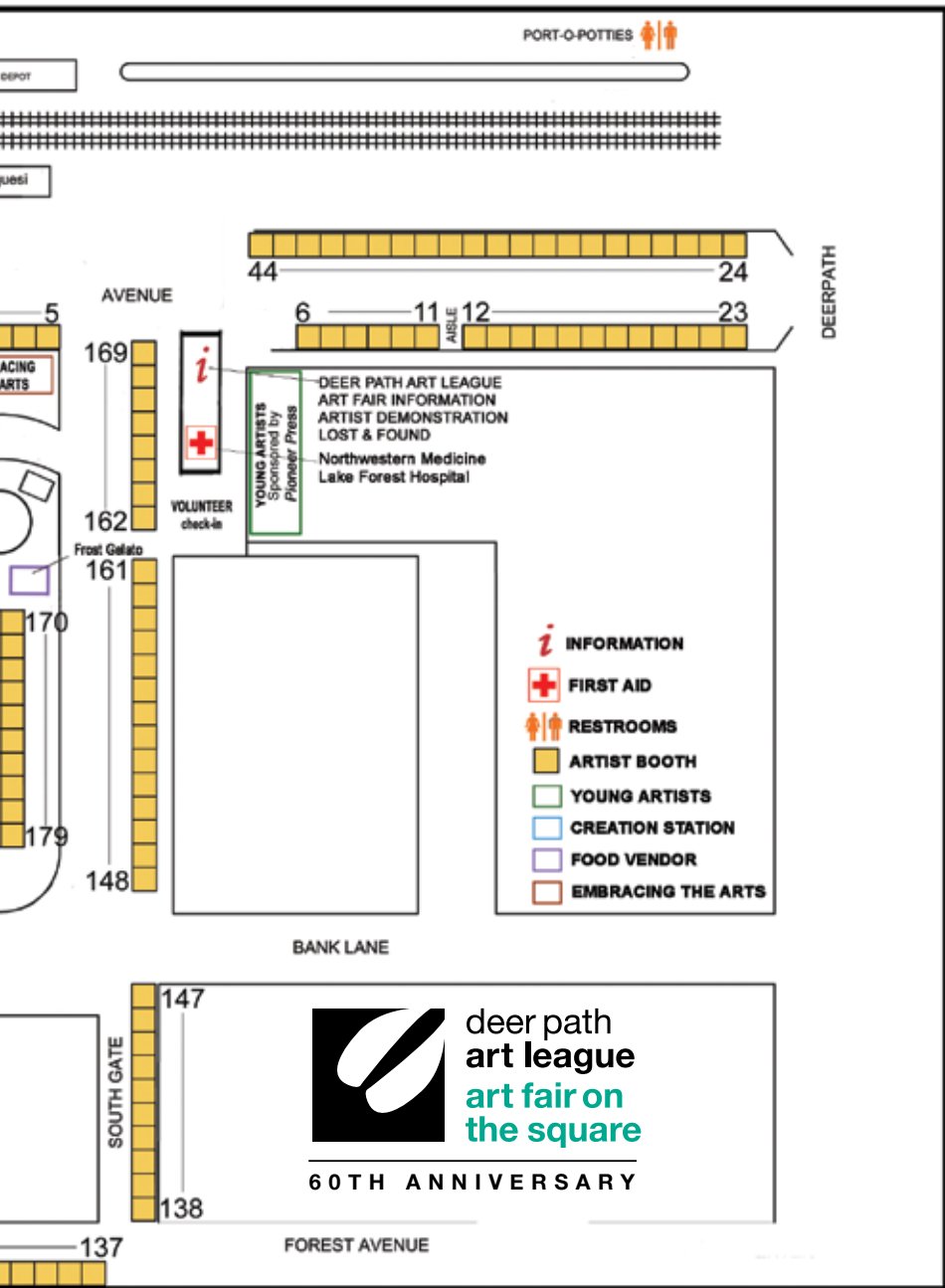
